This LENT we have our Church Weekend at Home which will be a wonderful time to connect together and pray into what God is doing with us in 2025 and beyond.

So rather than jump on any bandwagons, or lean into fashionable trends, we are going to press into the ancient practices and review our habits in them. This prayer diary will help us to be attentive to four key Christian practices:

- 1. **PRAYER** there's power in praying united prayers- so each day there are some short suggestions for prayer.
- 2. **READ/LISTEN TO SCRIPTURE** there's an invitation to start in Lent and over three months read/listen to the whole of the New Testament with Nicola.
- 3. **GATHER AS COMMUNITY** "do not stop meeting together.." Hebrews 10.25. There are some reflections on being God's community.
- 4. **LOVE** let us reflect together this Lent on being a people of love.

WEEK 1 - JUSTICE

Vision: Local people confident that they are loved, accepted and valued by the living God, the Father

Prayer focus: Local communities

Wednesday, 5th March

Bible reading: Matthew 1-4

Prayer points:

Pray for the area of Chiswick - for the people, community, schools, and places in this area.

DAY 2

Thursday, 6th March

Bible reading: Matthew 5-6

Prayer points:

Take some time today to pray for the area of Acton - for the people who are yet to know Jesus.

DAY 3

Friday, 7th March

Bible reading: Matthew 7-9

Prayer points:

Set a few minutes to pray for the area of Ealing - for people to come to Christ and let there be a revival in the area.

Saturday, 8th March

Bible reading: Matthew 10-12

Prayer points:

Give thanks and praise to God for the area of Brentford - for the community and people in that area.

Sunday, 9th March

Bible reading: Matthew 13-14

Prayer points:

LOVE - is there anything small or big God is asking of you to show his love in the community where God has planted you? In different seasons God asks different things - what is God saying to you in this season?

DAY 5

Monday, 10th March

Bible reading: Matthew 15-17

Prayer points:

Pray over the area of Isleworth, that people may come to know God's name.

Tuesday, 11th March

Bible reading: Matthew 18-19

Prayer points:

Pray for our local MP - Andy Slaughter and the Hounslow Council, for all their work for the community.

WEEK 2 - TRUTH

Vision: Our people as a movement of disciples equipped to follow Jesus Monday-Sunday at home and in the workplace.

Prayer focus: Ourselves and Family

Bible reading: Matthew 20-21

Ask God to teach us to be a humble and faithful servant for His Kingdom.

Thursday, 13th March

Bible reading: Matthew 22-23

Prayer points:

Pray that God reveals His divine identity to any of your family members or friends who are yet to know Christ.

Bible reading: Matthew 24-25

Prayer points:

Ask God for His guidance in the uncertainty - and to be prepared for Jesus' return.

Saturday, 15th March

Bible reading: Matthew 26

Prayer points:

Pray for forgiveness for all our wrongdoings, and for the strength to forgive others.

Sunday, 16th March

Bible reading: Mark 1-3

Prayer points:

Pray that may God give us strength and guidance to flee from any temptations.

DAY 12

Tuesday, 18th March

Bible reading: Mark 4-5

Prayer points:

Pray for a firm faith in Jesus - allowing us to experience the fullness of God's work in our life.

Sunday, 16th March

Bible reading: Matthew 27-28

Reflection:

need of God and just how much grace we have been shown by Jesus. In this first reflection there is an encouragement to spend sometime with God seeking forgiveness and asking for God's help to be free from any unforgiveness (where there is deep hurt this often is a work in progress). According to Freedom in Christ 70% of church attenders need to forgive their leaders either because they have done something wrong OR because they have had an expectation that has not been met. It is equally true that many church leaders will have felt unsupported or hurt and need to forgive. We will all from time to time need to forgive one another when we live in Christian community.

This LENT God wants to set us free and help us let go of any unforgiveness in church or outside of the church and help us to step into loving freedom.

Ask God to show you if there are any steps you need to take to forgive (sometimes we need to forgive ourselves) or seek forgiveness? Please reach out if you would value having support in this. The clergy team would love to see you or point you in the direction of further help.

Prayer points:


Pray for our Midweek Toddler Groups - let it be a space to bless the community and an opportunity to evangelise.

Bible reading: John 8-9


Prayer points:
